With a PhD in Islamic art history from SOAS, University of London, her work focuses on the art and architecture of the western Mediterranean with a particular interest in Islamic Spain. She was an Art Histories fellow at the Forum Transregionale Studien in Berlin (2013-14) based at the Museum für Islamische Kunst in Berlin. From 2015-2018 she was a Bilderfahrzeuge fellow at the Warburg Institute, School of Advanced Study. Her book on the Alhambra will be published by the KHI Florence and the Staatliche Museen zu Berlin (2019).
