Mark Evans, the founder and executive director of Outward Bound Oman, the first Outward Bound school established in the Arabic speaking world, has been involved in outdoor education for 40 years. He is Patron of The Andrew Croft Memorial Fund. In 2005, Mark was cited by Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth as a Pioneer of the Nation for his work in outdoor education. In 2012, he was awarded the MBE for his work in using challenging outdoor journeys as a vehicle for intercultural dialogue. He is a Fellow of The Royal Geographical Society, an Honorary Fellow of the Royal Scottish Geographical Society and has personally led challenging expeditions across Greenland and the Canadian High Arctic. In 2016, Mark led a 49-day 1,700 km crossing of the largest sand desert on earth, from Salalah to Doha.
